1. The RFP states that if a drug screen result is contested the test would need to be sent to another lab for testing, would that hold true if all testing is completed in house? Our company is CLIA lab certified, this allows lower cut off levels and is the BIG reason we use CLIA. There is a minimum amount of drug that must be in the system for a positive test, in other words we can detect more and do all testing at our own site, is this okay?
 - a. If your company does their own testing then that would suffice, the only situation we can think of where that would occur would be during a court hearing and if it would be requested by a judge, law enforcement, etc. Yes, that is fine.
2. Page 3, regarding 3rd party testing, if confirmation can be completed at the company's own lab do they need to send the test to someone else to confirm?
 - a. No, there would be no need to send it to a 3rd party, unless requested by a judge, law enforcement, etc.
3. This RFP is just the bid for lab confirmed oral fluid, correct?
 - a. Yes, years ago we had a nurse that came to the office to complete urine screenings but that has since gone away.
